

Haiti Hurricane Appeal

On October 4 Hurricane Matthew caused widespread damage through the west of Haiti. The government of Haiti says 1.4 million people need humanitarian assistance – 70% already lived in poverty. Homes and crops have been destroyed. Floods and massive landslides have swept livelihoods away. Cholera is a major fear.

CWS partner the Institut Culturel Karl Lévêque is asking for help so they can distribute food, safe water, first aid kits and shelter to people in the communities where they work. They work with peasant farmers in remote communities who receive no other help. Long term they want to help them rebuild homes and replace lost animals and crops. ACT Alliance Haiti (Action by Churches Together) is assisting in other communities.
