Some are surviving on one meal a day if emergency rations or labouring work is available. They are worried about catching the virus, as there is no money for medical treatment even when it is available. People living in cramped refugee camps or makeshift shelter with limited water are anxious about the future.

Every day they face dangerous choices and worry which will get them first – hunger or Covid-19. Our partners know who the most vulnerable people are and what they need. In Sri Lanka, they have distributed food to some agricultural workers, in Nicaragua, they have donated hygiene kits to small farmers and in Jordan, they are making hundreds of facemasks. The need is great. Many more people need their help to get these simple protection measures. If they act now, they can save many more lives.
