The world's most vulnerable and disadvantaged people are working hard to help themselves, but to do so they do need loving friends and neighbours like you... and Steve.




STEVE GOLDSMITH: A FRIEND IN NEED

A GIFT FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS

You have been generous and kind throughout your life, but with your Will, you can have your greatest impact on those who need food, water and justice.

Here are three current CWS project needs. They serve as practical, tangible examples of how – when the time comes - your Legacy could

bring change that lasts for generations.

\$28,000 for orphans in Uganda.

Imagine your Bequest being used to build 60 rainwater tanks for families that have fostered children who have lost their parents to HIV and AIDS.

\$47,000 to protect young girls in India.

Think how much difference your Bequest could make in communities where violence against girls and women is common. You could save lives and protect them from being abused, kidnapped or trafficked.

\$220,000 to bring water to the West Bank.

Your Legacy could live on in the Palestinian villages that are desperate for water. Imagine your gift being used to expand and replace old and broken water systems, so people no longer need to go thirsty.





Talk to your loved ones then update your Will or create a Codicil.

It's good for your family to know in advance that you want your estate to support people in need, through CWS and your other charities.

It is recommended that you update your Will every seven years or so, or as your personal circumstances change.

If you decide to leave a gift for CWS, you can choose to support:

- a General Bequest to be used where it is needed most – recommended as priorities can change quickly;
- a Gift for our Capital Fund, where it will earn interest that contributes to our annual work or helps with a special project agreed by the CWS Board;
- a Specific Project or Country, such as rainwater tanks for children;
- an Area of Need from community development to disaster response.

Your Bequest can take the form of:

- An Amount a cash donation or percentage of your estate.
- An Item such as property, investments, jewellery or life insurance policy.
- A Residual Bequest this is a very special Legacy in that once all your loved ones and financial matters are taken care of, the remainder of your estate goes to assist people in great need.

CREATING A CODICIL

If you decide to leave a gift for CWS, you don't have to update your Will. You can create a single-page amendment called a Codicil. It is a very straightforward form. You can find one enclosed and on the **Leave a Legacy** page of our website.
