

Fiji Emergency Appeal

Cyclone Winston ripped apart homes and livelihoods when it hit Fiji with wind gusts up to 325 kilometres an hour. Those directly in its path are facing a marathon clean-up job. They need help with food until they can replant and harvest crops, and with shelter so they can build back better.

CWS partner the Social Empowerment and Education Programme is helping isolated communities in the interior of Viti Levu with food and shelter. They are organising youth groups to provide psychosocial care for children. The Ecumenical Centre for Research and Advocacy, Peoples Community and Pacific Conference of Churches are all doing what they can to deliver comfort and help.
