South Sudan Famine Appeal

The race is on to save lives in South Sudan. The United Nations declared famine in Unity State in February. By July, it predicts 5.5 million people (47% of the population) will be in desperate need of food, a consequence of drought and conflict. Many are already surviving on the traditional hunger food, wild leaves.

CWS partner the Maridi Service Agency is helping displaced people with livelihood support in Maridi. ACT Alliance South Sudan (Action by Churches Together) is assisting people across the country but we are appealing for those in worst hit Unity and Bahr Al Ghazal States.
