Syrian refugees are finding it harder to survive after more than six years at war. In Jordan and Lebanon, they are living a hand to mouth existence. The lack of international funding means UN agencies have cut services. Refugees are finding it harder to survive and more stressed than ever. They are skipping meals and more children are being forced into work.

Your donation will make sure CWS partner the Department of Service to Palestinian Refugees keep the lifeline going to Syrian refugees. It will fund free medical clinics in Jordan's refugee camps and food or cash assistance to Syrian refugees in Jordan and Lebanon.
