Give Tongans a Hand

Families lost homes, gardens and livelihoods when Cyclone Gita swept through Tongatapu and 'Eua overnight on February 12. The category 4 storm affected an estimated 70% of the population leaving roads blocked by fallen trees, power lines and debris. Food crops have been lost or badly damaged. The New Zealand Government has sent emergency supplies but people will need help to get back on their feet.

Our partner Tonga Community Development Trust had trained its members in disaster preparedness, to repair rainwater systems and improve their gardens. These skills will help with the recovery. The Tonga National Council of Churches will also be assessing where best to help and make sure no one misses out. CWS will work with ACT Alliance (Action by Churches Together), to respond to local priorties.
