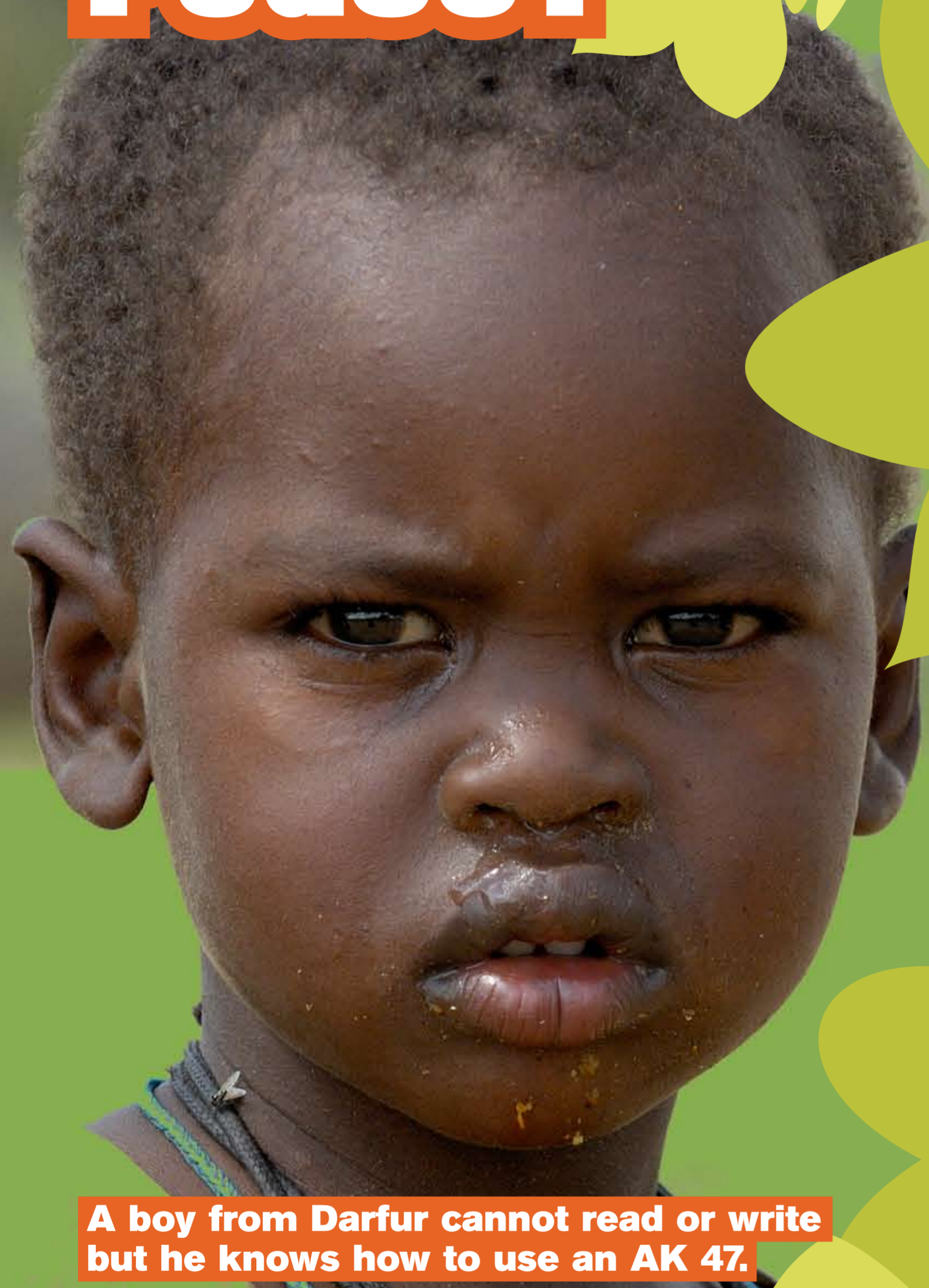


WHO WILL PAY THE PRICE OF PEACE?
